**EMPLOYMENT TO LOCAL PEOPLE**

2944. SHRI OM BIRLA:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has issued any guidelines for according priority in employment in nuclear power plants to local people living in the vicinity of such plants and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the names of the nuclear plants wherein the said guidelines have been complied with while making appointments during the last three years; and
- (c) the number of locals employed along with the details thereof including in Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu, plant-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH):
