IMPORT OF URANIUM FROM RUSSIA AND KAZAKHSTAN

1281. SHRI ANUBHAV MOHANTY:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether India is importing Uranium from Russia and Kazakhstan only;
- (b) if so, what is the reason for Uranium being imported from only these two countries;
- (c) whether the quantity of Uranium imported suffices domestic requirement;
- (d) if not, whether there is any proposal to import Uranium from any other country/countries; and
- (e) If so, which are the countries from where India is proposing to import Uranium?
