NUCLEAR LIABILITY LAW

807. SHRIMATI JAYA BACHCHAN:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether many countries have expressed their concerns regarding the nuclear liability law;
- (b) if so, what is Government's stand on this regard;
- (c) whether Government plans to amend the law or water it down to address international concerns; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

To address such concerns, clarification was provided by the Government along the lines of 'Frequently Asked Questions' (FAQs), posted on websites of Ministry of External Affairs and Department of Atomic Energy on February 8, 2015.
