**DANGER OF REDIOACTIVE MATERIAL IN KERALA**

- (a) whether Government has noticed about the danger of radioactive materials deposited as residuals in IRE campus and adjacent areas in Chavara, Kollam in Kerala; and
- (b) if so, what measures were taken to solve the issue, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (Dr. JITENDRA SINGH):
